

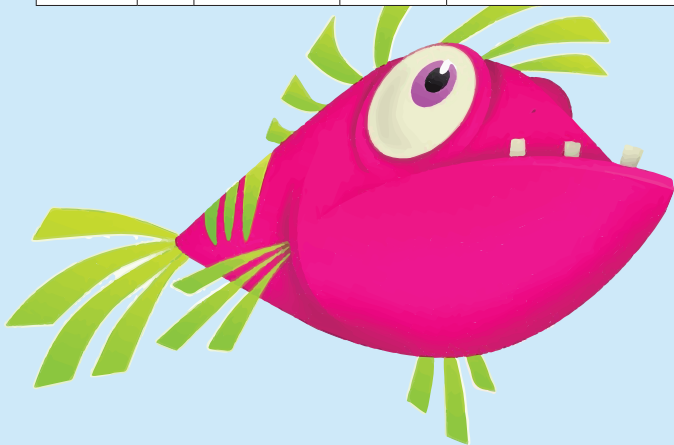
SPECIAL INTERESTS AND TOT SPORTS
