Living Memory Terms and Conditions

The Friends of the Plainfield Park District invites residents to honor family members and fellow residents with a planting of a tree or bench in a public park or along the trail system. This following information is intended to clarify the terms, conditions and requirements for this method of remembering the departed.

1. The Director of Parks & Planning or their designated staff reserves the right to select the location and species of a tree and/or bench in the selected park or property. Plainfield Park District staff will work with the person purchasing the honor item to find a mutually agreeable location and tree species where applicable.
2. Trees are typically planted during the spring or fall during the District tree replacement program when the planting success rate is best. Scheduling of the tree planting also will be at the discretion of the Director of Parks or their designated staff. Plainfield Park District staff will work with the person purchasing the tree to find a mutually agreeable date and location, which is also contingent on weather and soil conditions.
3. All Plainfield Park District ordinances and local municipal rules must be followed, and should any part of this policy be found to be in conflict with ordinances, park rules or other laws, then this policy shall not govern but the applicable law or park rule shall govern.
4. The District shall use best management practices to assist the tree so that it survives and thrives.
