



Drive in Movie Information & Guidelines

PARKING:

- The Drive in Movie site is located in the North parking lot at Bott Park, 24550 W Renwick Rd.
- Drive in Movie site will open at 7:45pm. Cars will not be allowed to park prior to 7:45pm. All vehicles must be parked by 8:45pm.
- Cars will enter the main entrance to Bott Park off of Renwick Rd.
- The person whose name that is registered for the movie, must be in the car when checking in. Registration may not be transferred to another person. If you are unable to attend the movie, please contact Beth Brannen to cancel your spot so we can accommodate someone on the waitlist.
- As you enter, you will be directed to park to allow for proper social distancing.
- Larger vehicles, SUV, Minivans and Trucks will be parked in the back.
- Motorcycles, RV, Campers and Trailers are not allowed.
- You may have your back-hatch door open during the movie. Please notify parking staff if you would like to back your car into the space. Everyone must remain in their vehicle for the duration of the movie.

SOUND:

- Sound will be through an FM transmitter. We will announce the radio station to tune into so you can listen from your car radio. You are welcome to bring a radio from home.

RESTROOMS:

- Restrooms at Bott Park will be available. Please maintain 6ft from others and wear a mask while going to and from the restrooms, and while in line.

GUIDELINES:

- Everyone must remain in their vehicle for the duration of the movie.
- Please wear a mask or face covering at all times if you exit your car.
- Social distancing of at least 6 ft. must be maintained at all times from others when you are out of your car and in line for the restroom.
- Socializing between vehicles is discouraged.
- Drive ups without a confirmed preregistration will not be allowed.
- Walk ins will not be allowed.
- You may bring your own food and snacks
- Grills/grilling are not allowed.
- **Alcohol is prohibited**
- Pets are not allowed.
- Smoking is not allowed outside of your vehicle.
- To provide a safe event for all participants, we kindly ask that you stay home if you are not feeling well or are experiencing any symptoms related to COVID-19.
- Daytime running lights - in order for all to have a positive movie viewing experience, we are asking you to turn off your daytime running lights, after you are parked. If you are unable to turn off your daytime running lights, we suggest you bring black garbage bags and painters tape to cover your lights.
- Vehicles that leave the Drive in Movie site, will not be allowed to re-enter.
- If there is inclement weather on movie day and we have to cancel the event, we will notify you by email, by 5pm on the day of the event.

EMERGENCIES:

- Inclement Weather – an announcement will be made, if we need to stop the movie and evacuate the site.
- First Aid/Accident - limited First Aid supplies; ice packs, band aids will be available, if you need medical assistance please call 911 and notify a staff member.
- Staff will be wearing yellow reflective vests. If you need assistance during the event, please see a staff member.
