Skate Park Usage Regulations

This facility is open to general public usage under the following regulations through the Plainfield Park District.

- Facility hours: 8a-Dusk.
- Usage of this facility is considered a recreational activity with inherent risks of serious injury. This facility is unsupervised.
- It is required for all users to wear proper protective equipment including: helmets, elbow pads, knee pads, etc., during all skating/biking activities.
- Food, glass, or alcoholic beverages are not permitted in park area.
- Users are responsible for inspecting the equipment prior to use to ensure it has not been vandalized and is safe for usage. Do not use the equipment if broken or wet.
- Specific days/hours will be posted for skateboard and bike users. The skate park will be open for free usage aside from these specified hours. Skateboarders and bikers who arrive during their allotted time will be given priority during that time.
- No personally owned ramps, boxes or other devices may be brought into the facility.
- Please be courteous to other users.
- Refrain from inappropriate activity and horseplay at all times.
- Enjoy your skate park.
